next and final stage will be to alter the Chapel path as it enters from Pemberley Avenue and to landscape the area behind the Chapel. A start has already been made in this area by removing the delapidated privet hedges but if the path is to be realigned this has to be financed. Although the Fund now stands at just over  $\pounds1700$  more money will be necessary, so please, if you have not already done so, send your donations to A. C. Fitt at the School.
